The title of his book, "*Never Give Up*", perfectly sums up his approach to living a full life. Phil modeled a lifetime of integrity and he promoted the development of good character, positive attitude and conduct, and respect of others - - leading SBART to grant the Phil Womble Ethics in Sports Award to student-athletes (from eight local high schools) who demonstrate the highest standards of ethics and sportsmanship. The Womble scholarship will be awarded each year to one of these awardees.

Pintard adds, "This new Phil Womble Scholarship is the perfect way to help high school student athletes to pursue their college dreams, and it does so by honoring a man that epitomized character and tenacity".

SBART is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization and it plans on raising the remaining funds through individual donations on or before January 31, 2019
