More than five decades ago, Jerry Harwin and Caesar Uyesaka sipped coffee at Caesar's Restaurant, talking about the need for a sports group in Santa Barbara that could help the local athletic community in times of need. After Jerry and Caesar shared a couple more coffee breaks together, the Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table was born. Its motto: The advancement and betterment of all sports and athletics in the greater Santa Barbara area.

The SBART got off to a fast start. Its first organizational meeting was held at Santa Barbara's East Beach on January 25, 1968. Hundreds of people attended this meeting, and over 200 joined that evening as Charter Members.

The SBART's first annual banquet was held at Santa Barbara City College on June 22, 1968. Through membership dues, contributions, fundraising events and local foundations, the Round Table has raised more than \$2 million for local athletics.

Harry's Plaza Café was the site of the SBART's first press luncheon held on September 14, 1970. The luncheons, initiated by the new president, Bill Bertka, were similar to a "Monday Morning Quarterback Club." All area schools were represented by the head coaches of the sports in season. For over four decades the SBART luncheons have been held at Harry's every Monday, attended by standing-room-only crowds.

Since its first meeting back in 1968, the Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table has helped thousands of individuals and organizations by raising funds to support their athletic programs. The Round Table is proud to help student-athletes at all levels compete in events they would otherwise not have been able to attend.

It is with our deepest regards and warmest thanks that we acknowledge and celebrate the vision and hard work of our founders, Caesar Uyesaka, Jerry Harwin and Bill Bertka.

The Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table Scholar Athlete of the Year Award was initiated in September 1986 after the Round Table's Board of Directors recognized the need to honor those students who are not only successful athletes, but who also maintain strong academic and extra-curricular credentials.

Qualifications for nomination include participation in varsity athletics at the high school level and in designated athletic programs at the college level. Academic qualifications include outstanding grade point averages, usually greater than 3.5, in conjunction with other scholarly activities such as honor societies, scientific societies, extra-curricular activities and outstanding aptitude test scores for high school. Students have been selected by principals, senior counselors, athletic directors and coaches at the various high schools and colleges in the Santa Barbara area, in association with the Athletic Round Table.

The Round Table feels that the significance of this award goes beyond recognizing individual students who have outstanding academic and athletic records. It is also a reminder to the community that it is possible for a student to participate in athletics and

Russell Hargreaves Award

JORDON DYER, 805 BEACH VOLLEYBALL CLUB



As a 5th generation Santa Barbarian, Jordon Dyer is deeply rooted in the Santa Barbara community. Jordon's passion for beach volleyball began while spending childhood summers in East Beach volleyball summer camps. After graduating from Dos Pueblos High School, Jordon became a member of the USA Men's Youth Beach Volleyball National Team (2009-2013), and graduated from California State University, Long Beach.

Jordon's experience coaching volleyball began at California State University, Long Beach with the women's beach volleyball team. He helped lead the women's team to two national top-10 finishes in NCAA Division I. After Long Beach, Jordon coached women's beach volleyball at Stetson University (Florida) where he helped lead the women's program to 2

conference championships and top 10 national rankings. Jordon has also been an active coach for the USA Youth High Performance Beach Volleyball Program.

Jordon's lifelong focus is to develop the volleyball community in Santa Barbara. He is currently involved in the following organizations: Santa Barbara City College, Santa Barbara Volleyball Club (Girls' Head Coach), Cate High School (Girls' Varsity Head Coach), UCSB (Volleyball Class Instructor), California Beach Volleyball Association (Tournament Director), and 805 Beach Volleyball Club (Founder, Director, and Coach).

Jordon has been an independent contractor with the City of Santa Barbara Parks and Recreation Department coordinating beach volleyball programs since 2020. He took over the summer camp reins after the retirement of Jon Lee and at the height of the Covid-19 pandemic. Jordon stepped in during a challenging time to ensure the summer volleyball camps continued and were available to interested kids and families. Jordon ensured the continued success of the summer volleyball camps while creating and enforcing all safety protocols during a challenging and fluid period. Jordon continues to coordinate summer volleyball camps while also managing Parks and Recreation's youth classes and clinics; and the popular adult intermediate/advanced evening classes.

In 2021 Jordon was hired as the California Beach Volleyball Association (CBVA) tournament director in Santa Barbara. He quickly increased the number of youth and adult weekend tournaments while also increasing team participation.

Jordon is a respected beach volleyball player, a leader in the community, a positive role model to all youth, a valuable asset to the City of Santa Barbara's Parks and Recreation Department, and a worthy 2023 Russ Hargreaves Award recipient.

Russ Hargreaves was a dedicated member of the Santa Barbara Recreation Department. He spent a lifetime creating opportunities for others to enjoy the benefits of recreational activities. He loved jogging and was committed to total body fitness. He knew that a healthy mind and body were the first steps to a happy and productive life. This award is given to a person recognized by the Parks & Recreation Department as a leader in maintaining quality sports programs

Master Athlete Award

Dave & deanna odell

Dave and DeAnna Odell met in the 200 Building of Millikan High School in Long Beach in 1983. It was love at first sight..... for Dave. It actually took Dave 10 years to get to the finish line with DeAnna when they were married in the summer of 1993. After spending the next 20 years starting a business (or two) and their family....raising three would-be college athletes, Walker, Raynee, and Rallie, the couple found enjoyment in running together and with friends in Santa Barbara.



In 2013, Dave and DeAnna decided to celebrate their 20th wedding anniversary by doing a couple's trail race, called the TransRockies. The race had six stages and covered 120 miles, going from Buena Vista Colorado to Vail. That race started their love affair with the trails and ultramarathon events that has covered the last decade. (For those not in the know, an ultra marathon is any race with a distance longer than a marathon (26.2 miles).

Since 2013, Dave and DeAnna have finished a combined 63 ultramarathons, including 13 finishes of races 100 miles or more. Racing mountainous, hundred-mile events has become their favorite running activity, with finishes at prestigious races like the Cascade Crest 100, Leadville 100, Western States 100, HURT 100, and High Lonesome 100. As big supporters of the local running scene, the Odell's have finished a combined eleven Santa Barbara Nine Trails 35 mile races. In that event, the classic ultra in our area, DeAnna has one first-place women's finish and two of the top three times in race history for women over age 50.

The last year had some memorable achievements for Team Odell. Dave completed the grueling Cocodona 250 (yes..250 miles), finishing in the top 30 overall and was the first finisher over age 50 in a time of 93 hours. The race started in Prescott Arizona and made its way to the finish line in Flagstaff. (Note - This was not a stage race. He slept a total of 3 hours during the 93-hour run.) DeAnna ran 200 miles of that race, until an injury sidelined her. DeAnna had a big year as well, on the podium overall for the Mammoth Trail Fest three-day event and First Place for women over age 50.

Already this year, DeAnna and Dave have run the Leona Divide 100K and DeAnna finished her seventh Boston Marathon. In late July, the couple will celebrate their 30th wedding anniversary by together toeing the line at the Angeles Crest 100, which runs from Wrightwood to Alta Dena with over 23,000 feet of vertical elevation.

Dave and DeAnna Odell are truly Master Athletes.

This award was established and endowed by Louise Lowry Davis to encourage the continued participation in competitive sports, regardless of age. It is given for achievement by an athlete over the age of 40 years.
