### **SBART Founders**



More than five decades ago, Jerry Harwin and Caesar Uyesaka sipped coffee at Caesar's Restaurant, talking about the need for a sports group in Santa Barbara that could help the local athletic community in times of need. After Jerry and Caesar shared a couple more coffee breaks together, the Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table was born. Its motto: The advancement and betterment of all sports and athletics in the greater Santa Barbara area.

The SBART got off to a fast start. Its first organizational meeting was held at Santa Barbara's East Beach on January 25, 1968. Hundreds of people attended this meeting, and over 200 joined that evening as Charter Members.

The SBART's first annual banquet was held at Santa Barbara City College on June 22, 1968. Through membership dues, contributions, fundraising events and local foundations, the Round Table has raised more than \$2 million for local athletics.

Harry's Plaza Café was the site of the SBART's first press luncheon held on September 14, 1970. The luncheons, initiated by the new president, Bill Bertka, were similar to a "Monday Morning Quarterback Club." All area schools were represented by the head coaches of the sports in season. For over four decades the SBART luncheons have been held at Harry's every Monday, attended by standing-room-only crowds.

Since its first meeting back in 1968, the Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table has helped thousands of individuals and organizations by raising funds to support their athletic programs. The Round Table is proud to help student-athletes at all levels compete in events they would otherwise not have been able to attend.

It is with our deepest regards and warmest thanks that we acknowledge and celebrate the vision and hard work of our founders, Caesar Uyesaka, Jerry Harwin and Bill Bertka.



### Scholar Athletes of the Year

The Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table Scholar Athlete of the Year Award was initiated in September 1986 after the Round Table's Board of Directors recognized the need to honor those students who are not only successful athletes, but who also maintain strong academic and extra-curricular credentials.

Qualifications for nomination include participation in varsity athletics at the high school level and in designated athletic programs at the college level. Academic qualifications include outstanding grade point averages, usually greater than 3.5, in conjunction with other scholarly activities such as honor societies, scientific societies, extra-curricular activities and outstanding aptitude test scores for high school. Students have been selected by principals, senior counselors, athletic directors and coaches at the various high schools and colleges in the Santa Barbara area, in association with the Athletic Round Table.

The Round Table feels that the significance of this award goes beyond recognizing individual students who have outstanding academic and athletic records. It is also a reminder to the community that it is possible for a student to participate in athletics and still maintain outstanding academic achievement. 

# Russell Hargreaves Award



In the summer of 2016, Ted and Nevin Pallad and their four children decided to relocate from Palos Verdes, California, to Santa Barbara. Their primary motivation was to live closer to family and to introduce their children to the superior quality of life that Santa Barbara offers. Nevin was born and raised in Santa Barbara, and she is delighted to return and introduce Flag Football League (FNL) to her friends and family. Ted played tackle football for four years while growing up in Orange County. He is excited for his children to play football without the concern of potential

head injuries associated with contact sports. FNL provides a safe, fun, and exciting environment for children of all ages to enjoy. Family is the foundation of FNL, and we strive to provide everyone with unforgettable memories.

Russ Hargreaves was a dedicated member of the Santa Barbara Recreation Department. He spent a lifetime creating opportunities for others to enjoy the benefits of recreational activities. He loved jogging and was committed to total body fitness. He knew that a healthy mind and body were the first steps to a happy and productive life. This award is given to a person recognized by the Parks & Recreation Department as a leader in maintaining quality sports programs

### Master Athlete Award MAGGIE MASON



Maggie Mason became a long-distance runner by accident. In a bid to shed some weight and become more fit, she began commuting by bicycle to her job as an English teacher at Dos Pueblos High school, making the 24-mile round trip every day. With her usual resolve and determination, when faced with 50 MPH Santa Ana winds about four months into her program, Maggie soldiered on, never missing a day, but blowing out both knees in the process. After she recovered, her doctor told her to change her exercise routine, so she started running. Unschooled in the different energy demands of biking and running, Maggie thought she needed to run the same number of minutes as she formerly biked each day, so she started out her running program with 50-mile weeks. She fell in love with distance running, and ran her first marathon in March of 1998, finishing in 4:42. When she crossed the finish line, her first thought was, "I can do better than this!"

That was over 25 years ago. Since then, Maggie has ran 28 marathons, including 9 Boston Marathons, two National Masters Marathon Cham-

pionships where she placed 2nd in her age division, and winning or placing in her age category in 11 marathons to date. For over a decade, Maggie has been running national-class times in both local and national races, and she recently clocked a world-class time in the Ventura Half Marathon in February. Other highlights were finishing 3rd overall/1st Masters at the Avenue of the Giants Marathon; running her personal best time of 3:16 at age 51; breaking the course record for her age division in the California International Marathon at age 60; and coming in 6th in her AG at Boston during the worst weather in the history of the race, in 2018.

Now retired from teaching, Maggie lives with her husband Jeff and her 19-year old cat, Zoe-another long hauler! Running has given her a profound connection to life, vibrancy and friendship in her running community, as well as instilling resilience and endurance, which spills over into daily life lessons-she's learned to be more comfortable with discomfort, to ride out the bad patches, to hunker down for the miles ahead. Maggie attributes her longevity as a consistently high performer to her own inherent stubbornness and drive; to the wisdom of her coaches, Mike Swan and Rusty Snow; to the camaraderie and shared commitment of so many of her fellow runners in Santa Barbara Running and Racing; and to her willingness to back off when she feels flat or strained. "Whenever running becomes drudgery instead of joy, it's time to regroup. I always come back stronger and more exuberant."

This award was established and endowed by Louise Lowry Davis to encourage the continued participation in competitive sports, regardless of age. It is given for achievement by an athlete over the age of 40 years.
