**CHICK HEARN**

Again this year the Voice of Chick Hearn was heard broadcasting all the Laker games over Radio Station KNX (1070) in addition to simulcasting 20 other games for color telecast over KTLA (Channel 5).

Chick Hearn, the popular "Voice of the Lakers," has been at Courtside ever since the team moved to Los Angeles.

Born in Aurora, Illinois, Chick played collegiate basketball and later officiated in the Big 10. After World War II, Mr. Hearn began broadcasting Bradley University's basketball games and in the mid-1950s was hired by CBS to broadcast football and basketball contests for KNX.
